

# Examination and Promotions

A test or examination is an assessment intended to measure a test-taker's knowledge, skill' aptitude' physical fitness or classification in many other topics. A test may be administered verbally, on paper, on a computer or in a pre determined area that requires a test taker to demonstrate or perform a set of skills.

- After every lesson a diagnostic test is administered.
- Besides as per CBSE norms the system of examination consists of four periodic tests (best two) half yearly & 3.
- Minimum attendance requirement as per CBSE is 75% for being eligible to take Board and Home based Annual 4.
- Result declared at the end of the academic year is final and no request for re-examination shall be entertained. No answer sheet of final examinations will be shown or Re-evaluate.
- Any student found indulging in malpractice or unfair means during the examination is liable to be debarred from further examination. A committee will be appointed in this connection whose decision will be final. 6.
- Those who lose or damage the progress report shall pay Rs. 100/- for a new report card. 7.
- $Parents/Guardians\ shall\ not\ make\ any\ remark\ on\ the\ progress\ report\ besides\ affixing\ their\ signature.$

## **Admission Counselling**

### Registration and Admission

- 1. The School follows CBSE guidelines in admitting the students.
- 2. The academic session of the school is from April to March.
- 3. No candidate will be admitted without registration.
- 4. It is essential that an authentic Date of Birth Certificate/School Leaving Certificate must be produced at the time of admission.
- 5. Admission will not be taken merely on the basis of T. C. /Birth Certificate. The child will have to undergo necessary admission test.
- 6. Only parent or authorised guardian should be present at the time of admission of the candidate.
- 7. The head of the institution reserves the right to admit or reject a candidate without assigning any reason.
- 8. Incomplete Registration Forms shall not be entertained.
- 9. School Fee is payable in 2 Installments the first installment on or before 1st April and 2nd installment on or before 1st October.
- 10. The mode of payment can be Cheque & Online Payment (OBC / HDFC).
- 11. The name of the student will be struck of from the roll if the fee is not paid on time prior information must be given to the school in case of withdrawl.

#### School Rules

- 1. The students should come to school regularly in proper uniform.
- 2. Students should maintain a high standard of discipline.
- 3. Students are not allowed to leave the school campus without the permission of the Principal.
- 4. Students will have to participate in each and every activity of the school including tours, treks, excursions etc.
- 5. Immorality, grave insubordination, stealing, contempt of authority or breaking bounds is sufficient reason for immediate expelling from the school.
- 6. The decision of the Principal shall be final and binding on the parents/guardian/student in case of any dispute.
- 7. The parents and guardians will be bounded by the school rules and regulations as amended from time to time.
- 8. A student can be withdrawn from the school at the parent's request at the end of an academic session. If a student is withdrawn during the session, tuition, admission and annual fees paid will not be refunded. The withdraw of a student will be granted only on submission of a written application to the Principal one month prior to the withdrawal. No Dues Certificate, obtained from various sections of the school, will be required to clear for the issue of Transfer Certificate.
- 9. No student is allowed to use personal vehicle. However, in exceptional case permission can be granted only after an undertaking to this effect from the parents.
- 10. School will not be liable to compensate any claim arising out of illness, accident or any other cause.

### Serious Offences

A boy / Girl may be expelled for offences, which are likely to impair the discipline of the school, or for repeated misconduct and disregard for school rules. Parents and guardians may also be asked to withdraw their ward if his / her academic performance continues to be very poor.

Decision of the school disciplinary committee headed by principal in all such cases will be final.


