## Teachers

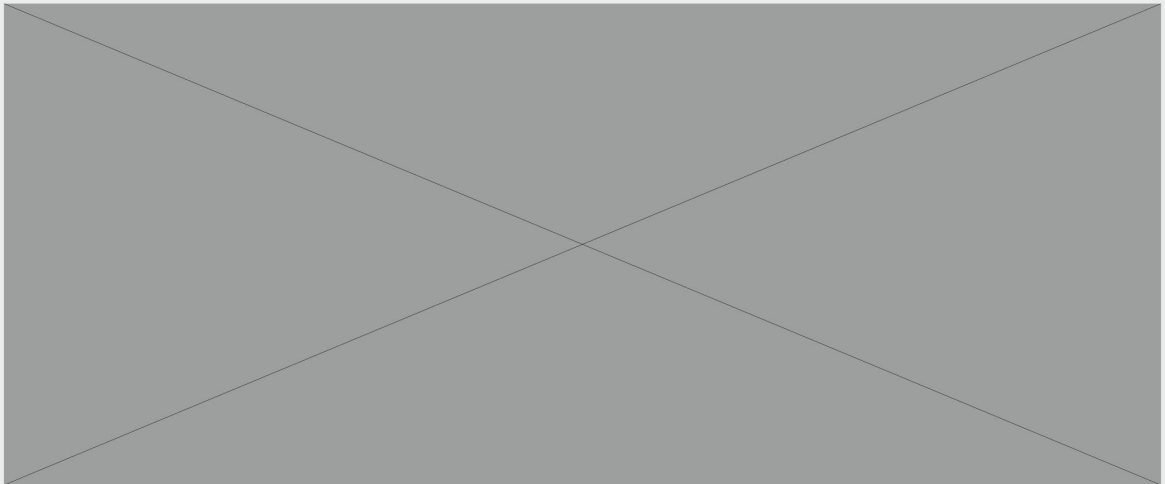

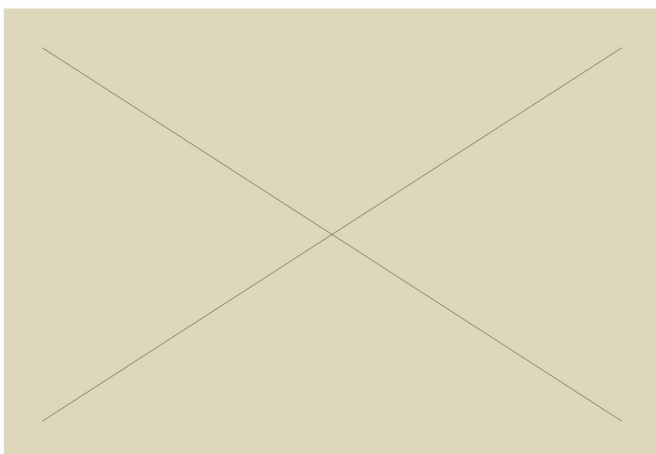
# Curriculum

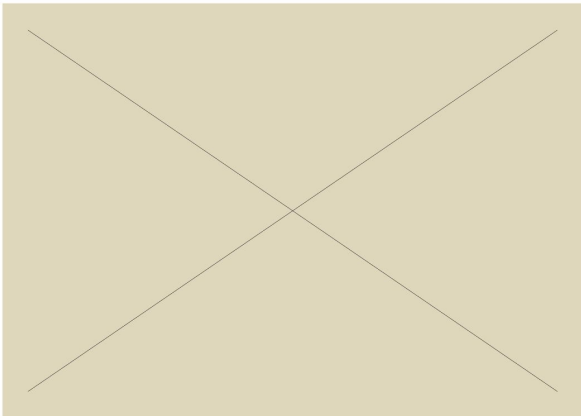


## Registration & Admission

- The academic session of the school starts from April to March.
- Candidate will not be admitted without registration.
- It is essential that an authentic Birth certificate/ Transfer certificate must be produced at the time of admission.
- Admission will not be given merely on the basis of T.C/ Birth certificate.
- The child will have to undergo necessary admission test.
- Only parents or genuine guardian shall present themselves at the time of admission of the candidate.
- The head of the institute reserves the right to admit or reject the candidate without assigning any reason thereof.
- Incomplete forms are not accepted.



# Board Preparation Programme

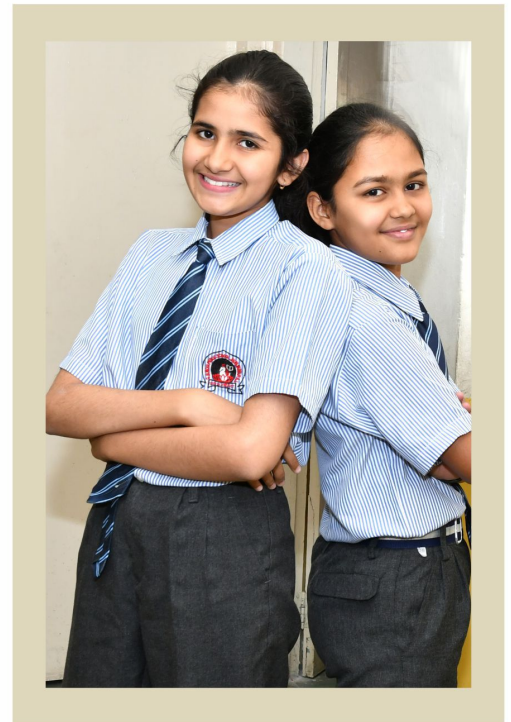


RACE ( Regular Analysis through Chapter wise Evaluation)  
Secret of Exquisite Success in Board Examinations

- Highly qualified, experienced, confident, dedicated staff having command over their subjects.
- Regular, effective class room teaching followed by Supervised Study Session.
- In time syllabus completion.
- Chapter wise detailed revision.
- Rigorous and continuous evaluation through a set 4 test series based on board pattern to develop competitive spirit among all students.
- Counselling with parents after every test series about their wards progress.
- A confident, fully prepared, tension free aspirant emerges out of the process and gets desired result in Board Examination.

## Examination & Promotion

- There is a continuous evaluation of students along with three terminals, half yearly and annual examinations.
- A pupil shall be eligible to appear in final examinations only if he/she has 75% attendance.
- Result declared at the end of the academic year is final and no request for re-examination shall be entertained. Answer sheets of final examinations shall not be shown. There is no provision for re-examination of terminal examination.
- Parents/Guardians are requested to examine the progress card of their wards and return it duly signed, to the class teacher within three days.
- Those students who are not present for examination of any subject shall not be considered for re-examination and will not be awarded any position. In case of grave illness, a medical certificate to the effect shall be produced.
- Criteria for promotion after final examination shall be 36% of marks in all the papers considering the aggregate marks obtained by the students in the examination and the internal assessment made by the school.
- Students who has failed for two consecutive years in the same shall not be permitted to continue his/her studies in the school.
- Any student found indulging in malpractice or unfair means during the examination. A committee will be appointed in this connection whose decision will be final.
- Those who lose or damage the progress report shall pay a fine of Rs. 50/- for new progress report.



## Learning Resource Centres

### Library -

The school has a spacious library containing a wide range of books, periodical and journals on literature, social sciences, novels, biographies, encyclopaedia etc. There is a wide variety of reference books to fulfill the academic needs and cultural interest of the students.

### Laboratories-

The school has well equipped science, social science, mathematics and computer, science laboratories. The students perform experiments under the guidance of subject teacher. The computer lab is equipped with latest PCs along with Wi-Fi connectivity.

### Music Room-

We have separate music room for our budding musicians to wash away from their soul the dust of everyday life and is rejuvenating. Students regularly perform during morning assembly and on various special and cultural occasions.

### Smart Classroom-

For the concept of blended learning the school has placed a digital learning technology, equipped with a specialised software 'Extramarks' for each and every class



## Teaching Technology & Methodology

The teaching environment is based on love, harmony & trust where the teachers teach with affection acting as motivators and guides. Well trained and dedicated lady teachers take care of tiny tots motherly. Teachers use student-centered teaching style which instills confidence, initiative and develops critical and analytical skills. Creativity finds expression through co-curricular activities like debates, recitations, quizzes, role-playing, dancing, singing, rangoli making, cooking and sports.



# Co-curricular Activities

- **Games & Sports:**

To create a competitive spirit among students, they are exposed to various competitions and activities. The school has spacious facilities for Basketball, Table tennis, Badminton, Skating, Tae-k-wondo, Martial Arts Regular competitions are being organised for games and sports. A balance of aerobic stretching and muscle exercises is provided through both indoor and outdoor games and sports. Students participate in various sports activities organised by different societies and institutions. House system encourages the students and boosts their morale for various competitions at intersection and class levels.



- **Indoor Activities:**

Students also get opportunity to play indoor games like Chess, Carom, Badminton, Skating, Table tennis etc. They have classes for dance, music, recitation, debate, craft etc. They are motivated to conduct science, social studies and craft exhibitions to develop imagination and creativity.

- **Tours, Picnics & Excursion :**

Students are taken to educational tours & picnics to different places to develop self-confidence and feeling of working together.

- **Cultural Activities :**

Cultural activities are a regular feature of the school. Students are motivated to present various cultural items on stage to overcome stage fright and improve their expression and hone their talent.

Regular religious and national festivals are organised with culture, tradition and spirit of patriotism.

## Personality Development Programmes

Students are encouraged to develop leadership traits by giving them ample opportunities to organise various events, functions, exhibitions and programmes with remote control and guidance from the faculty members. Various committees and councils of the students have been formed to train the students in planning and organisational skills. The school organises various workshops, exhibitions and seminars to give its students wide exposure and practical experience of learning. One hour zero period is devoted to develop communicative skills and personality development of the children.



## Pre-Primary

The naturally curious minds are exposed to conditions that can evoke freedom of thought and expression. Language development, concept formation, socio emotional skills along with fine and gross motor development happen simultaneously through exploration, interrogation and eventually selfdiscovery. This can build confident youngsters who feel free to be creative and motivated to learn.



## Primary

The highly developing toddler brain is stimulated through exploratory and hands-on activities, which can develop cognition, language and psychomotor skills. They begin to appreciate the importance of education by remaining interested through the flexible, thought stimulating lessons. They are made aware of their own potentials and learn how to explore and exploit in the right direction thus moving away from vulnerability to independence.
